Pray for a **situation or country** where justice and peace are needed, maybe for a place with which you feel connected.

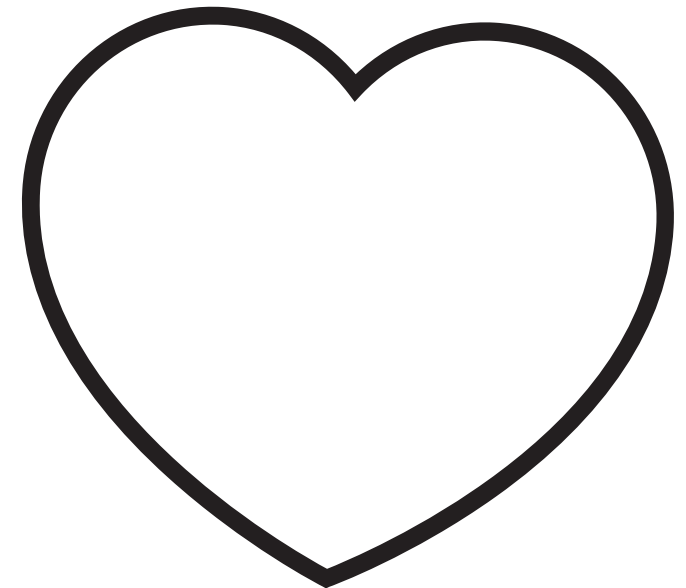
Write or draw a prayer on a post-it note and stick it on the country.

Pray for someone whose heart is broken. Those around you? Those who've been trafficked? Traffickers? You?

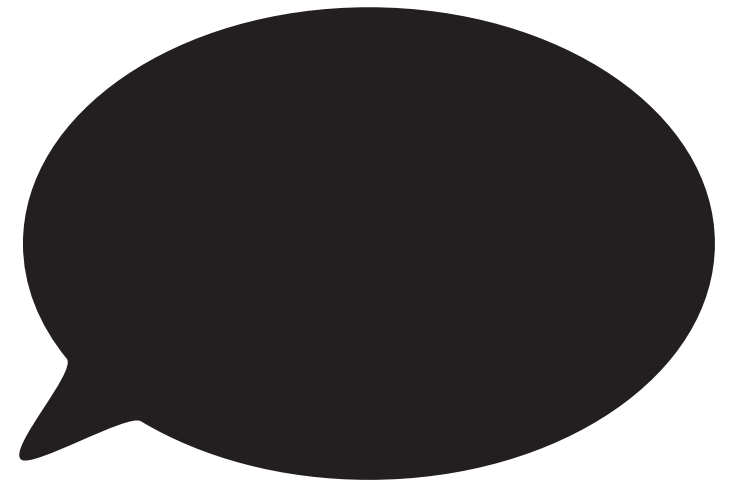
Take a plaster. Write something on it to represent the person and add it to the heart.

Think about one thing for which we, corporately, **need to repent** about modern-day slavery. Using the dough, **mould** your repentance.

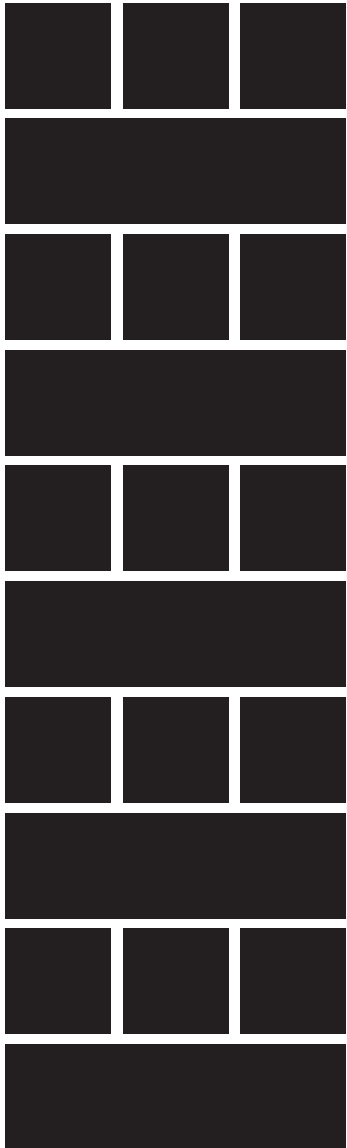
Squish it back into a blob! We thank God that He removes sin. Now mould the dough into the **future dreams** of those trapped in violent situations.
